

## **Class: Cool Color Scheme**

Alysa is redecorating her room in cool colors. Her grandmother bought her the blue, green, yellow, and white bedding in the picture. Help her select the paint for her walls, floor, bed, and table in a monochromatic blue scheme. (Bedding includes the quilt, comforter, sheets, pillow case, pillow shams, and throw pillows.)

Rank the paint selections from best to worst.

Samples: Visit a paint store to collect paint chips that reflect the descriptions below.

Official Placement: 4-1-2-3

Cuts: 1, 2, 4

#4 is the best color scheme. The sample paint selection is cool, blue, and monochromatic. Monochromatic means one or single color. The cool colors are violet (purple), blue-violet, blue, blue-green, green, and yellow-green.

#1 is the next best color scheme. The paint selection is cool and monochromatic but the color is yellow-green.

#2 is the third best color scheme. The paint selection is cool (blues and greens) but it is analogous not monochromatic blue. Analogous is a term used to describe colors that are adjacent (next) to each other on the color wheel.

#3 is the worst color scheme. The paint selection is monochromatic but it is warm yellow, not cool blue.
