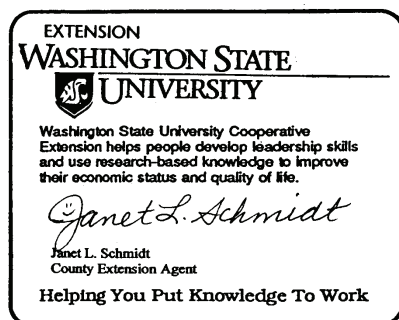

Directions to Panhandle 4-H Camp

Coming from the east side, use I-90 to I-5. You can turn south on I-405 which runs into I-5. Head south to Olympia and take the exit 104, going west. You will be on Highway 101. At about 5 miles Hy 101 veers right to Shelton, go that way. Stay on the divided hy, when you see a sign for Bremerton, get in the left lane, the road becomes 2 lanes. Follow directions below to the camp.

Coming from Yakima, take highway 12 to I-5. When you get to I-5 head towards Olympia. Coming from the South, head towards Olympia on I-5. Near Olympia, take exit 104 and stay on this section of road for 5 miles. Highway 101 goes off to the right, watch for signs saying Shelton highway 101. You are on a divided highway. Stay to the left lane when you see the Bremerton Highway 3 exit.

* You should now be on a 2 lane highway. Watch for an exit sign that says City Center./Dayton/ Matlock Road. Take this exit, stay to the left, make left turn at the stop sign. You are now on Dayton/ Matlock Road, drive 6 miles. As you pass the Dayton store about a 1/4 of a mile further you will see a 4-H sign on the right with an arrow pointing left. This is Highland Road, turn left onto it and drive 4 miles. You will see a large sign on the left, Panhandle 4-H Camp. Phone numbers if you get lost, 360-426-6323 or 360-426-9523.

4-H Shooting Sports Leader Training

This statewide leader training and certification supports the Washington State 4-H Policy regarding 4-H Shooting Sports instructors in Washington. The policy states that WA 4-H shooting sports instructors at the county level must:

- Be at least 21 years of age (18 years for assistant instructors).
- Be screened, trained, and appointed as a current 4-H Leader through their local County Extension Office.
- Successfully complete 15 hours of instructor-training session administered and sanctioned through the State 4-H Office.
- Be trained and certified in the discipline (rifle, shotgun, pistol, muzzle-loader, archery and hunting) that they are teaching at the county level.



Extension programs and employment are available to all without discrimination. Evidence of noncompliance may be reported through your local Extension office.
