# Flower, Fruit and Vegetable Garden Judges Training

## Who Benefits from Garden Training

Master Gardeners, current county fair produce and flower judges who want to update their knowledge; community residents who have considered entering produce or flowers in a fair, those who have entered and want to earn higher ribbons, 4-H garden project leaders, parents and senior members.

Upon completion you will have the opportunity to add your name to the Washington State and County Fair produce and flower judges' list.



You will want to put a few dollars in your pocket to take home a bouquet from Lily Lane Farms or feed their chickens.

## Training Location

The day will be started at the Westport Winery, 1 South Arbor Road, Aberdeen, [www.westportwines.com](http://www.westportwines.com); and continue through lunch. The last session will be at Lily Lane Farms, 8 John Wayne Lane, Aberdeen, [www.lilylanefarm.com](http://www.lilylanefarm.com); just down the road from the winery.

The weather is unpredictable so dress for cold, cool, warm or hot weather.

The class will go to the Lily Lane Farms flower cutting field even in rain or hail so please come prepared.

## Directions

From Aberdeen, take Hwy 105 toward Westport. Travel about nine miles past Grays Harbor College, the winery and farm is on the right. Turn off Hwy 105 at South Arbor Road. There is plenty of parking. If you get to the Ocean Spray plant, turn around and go back. Watch for the signs.

From Raymond, take Hwy 105 toward Westport; turn right toward Aberdeen at Twin Harbors State Park between Grayland and Westport and go about nine miles. First you will pass Lily Lane Farm the winery is on your left on the next street off Hwy 105. Watch for the signs after you pass the Ocean Spray plant.

## Requirements

To get the most out of this one day training, participants must be able to identify different types of produce and flowers.

## Training Schedule

- 10:00 am—Arrive at the Westport Winery and pick up registration packet.
- 4-H and open class judging. (Danish and the American system of judging)
- The ages and stages of the 4-H youth divisions.
- What to write as encouraging comments so they keep on entering.
- Vegetable standards.
- Lunch
- How to handle noxious week entries.



- Flower standards.
- Concluding at Lily Lane Farm to get hands on experience on how to pick flowers to enter in a fair.
- 4:00 pm—Thank you, evaluations, and good-bye.
