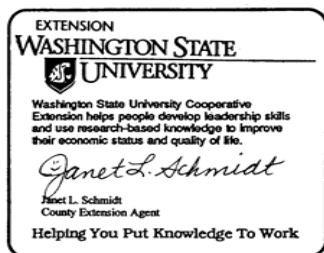

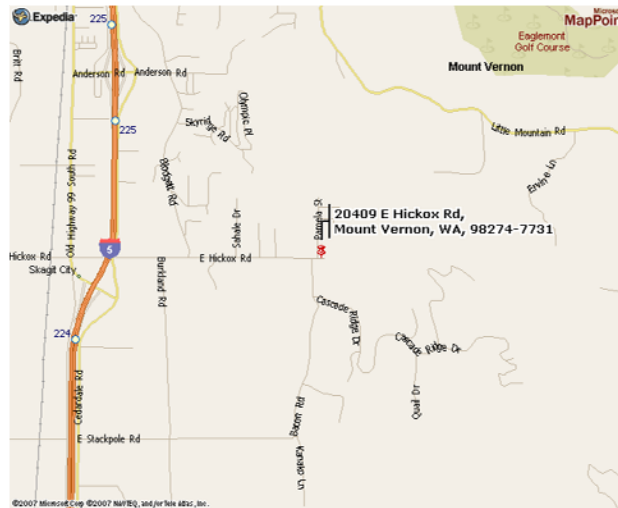

4-H Shooting Sports Leader Training

This statewide leader training and certification supports the Washington State 4-H Policy regarding 4-H Shooting Sports instructors in Washington. The policy states that WA 4-H shooting sports instructors at the county level must:

- Be at least 21 years of age (18 years for assistant instructors).
- Be screened, trained, and appointed as a current 4-H Leader through their local County Extension Office.
- Successfully complete 15 hours of instructor training session administered and sanctioned through the State 4-H Office.
- Be trained and certified in the discipline (rifle, shotgun, pistol, muzzle-loader, archery and hunting) that they are teaching at the county level.

Participants must attend the entire training to complete the 4-H shooting sports certification for Washington.

Persons requiring special accommodation while participating in this program may call 425-357-6044. Accommodation needs to be requested 2 weeks in advance otherwise it will not be guaranteed.

Extension programs and employment are available to all without discrimination. Evidence of noncompliance may be reported through your local Extension office.
