#### **Document Your Environment Multimedia Contest**

The National Archives in collaboration with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) today announced the launch of a student multimedia contest, "Document Your Environment." Drawing inspiration from a collection of environmental photos from the 1970s, this contest invites students, ages 13-18, college, and graduate students to create any type of graphic art, a short video, or a poem using a Documerica photo as a prompt. The grand prize for this contest will be \$500, courtesy of the Foundation for the National Archives. The contest is hosted on <http://documerica.challenge.gov>, the federal government's online challenge platform. The deadline for entries is **January 6, 2012**. Visit the website for contest details. Finalists and the grand prize winner will be announced in February 2012. Finalists may be featured in an upcoming exhibit at the National Archives and a traveling exhibit with the EPA.
