

Washington State 4-H Food & Nutrition Program Development Committee

Purpose: This committee is a program development and implementation committee responsible for the Washington State 4-H Food & Nutrition Program.

Responsibilities:

- Recommends, reviews and develops food and nutrition 4-H youth curriculum (projects and activities).
- Evaluates and processes food and nutrition recommendations from the Washington 4-H Council
- Promotes training for food judges.
- May assist with training and activities at State 4-H Conference.
- May assist with activities at State 4-H Fair.
- May promote and provide training for 4-H food and nutrition leaders.
- Maintains a listserv for 4-H food and nutrition leaders.

Membership:

- State Program Director, Extension 4-H Youth Specialist, are ex officio
- Open to all faculty, staff, and volunteers who are interested in advancing the 4-H food and nutrition program in the state.
- Size of working group: 10-12
- Ideal representation: all districts, new and experienced, position categories, large/small counties

Policies and Procedures:

- A face-to-face meeting is held annually following the State 4-H Council meeting.
- Development work may be done by ad-hoc committees.
